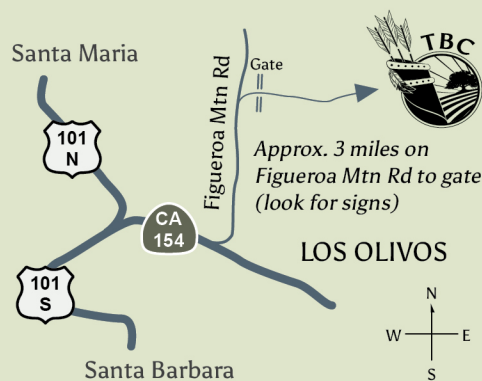
TRADITIONAL EQUIPMENT ONLY:

Longbow Aluminum/Carbon (LB/AC),
Longbow Wood (LB/W), Recurve (RC),
Selfbow (SB), & Asiatic Bow (AB)

Two arrows, 10-8-5 scoring
No elevated rests (Shoot off shelf or hand)
No stabilizers, sights, or clickers
No stringwalking or facewalking
Three shooters minimum per group

LAST ARCHER STANDING

Saturday afternoon at 4pm

- Entry fee: \$5
- Progressively challenging, shootdown format
- Different shot condition for each target. (Examples: "must hit the target" or "must be inside the insert" or "must be in the 8 ring," etc.)
- Each participant shoots one arrow. If they meet the given condition they progress to the next target. If they fail to meet the condition, they are eliminated
- Winner will claim a grand prize and a custom made award

SMOKER ROUND

Self guided, open all weekend

- Entry fee: \$5 (pay to play as many times as you would like)
- 10-target 3D course with extremely high chance of damaged or lost arrows
- The highest score for both male and female, at the end of the weekend claims a grand prize
- Participants are only allowed one arrow, they may bring components and materials for field repairs, but only one arrow or "shaft" is allowed

This course is challenging, expect obstacles and high consequence shots. Good luck!

BROADHEAD CHALLENGE

Saturday afternoon, following Last Archer Standing

- Entry fee: \$5
- Participants must utilize a broadhead for this event. We ask that you dull the broadhead for safety purposes
- This event will be held in a shootdown format concluding with the winner claiming a grand prize and a custom made award
- Shot condition: must hit vitals for all targets (utilizing an anatomical 3D deer target)
- The "cut line" of the broadhead will be the determination, not the arrow's shaft
- Each round we will increase the shooting distance until a champion is crowned

GEORGE PAPAC MEMORIAL LONG DISTANCE CLOUT

Sunday afternoon at 1pm

- Entry fee: \$5
- Participants will line up at an unknown distance +\~ 100 yards
- Closest arrow to the pin wins a grand prize and custom award

Come and join the barrage of arrows as they fly through the sky.

NEW FOR 2025!

Team Event (co-hosted by Nico Gallegos)

Takes place during the tournament Saturday and Sunday

- Participants will be required to register their team by Saturday morning at 9am
- A team must consist of 4 shooters
- Teams must include at least 3 different bow styles, at least 1 female and 1 Senior or Super Senior. Bonus points will be offered to Selfbow and Asiatic classes
- At the end of the tournament Sunday, scores will be totaled and posted for review
- The winning team will take home a perpetual trophy and have their names engraved in it with the corresponding year. They will also each win FREE REGISTRATION for the following year!

The trophy is to be returned to TBC year after year in this perpetual format. The winning team will not be allowed to sign up for the team event again the following year, participants will have to break up the team by at least 50% in order to register for the Team Event the following year.

Aerial Target Launcher

Open throughout the weekend Friday - Sunday

- \$3 for 6 arrows or \$5 for 12 arrows
- Flu-flu arrows of various spines are provided by the event (no woods provided)

Atlatl Challenge (co-hosted by Dave Eagleton)

Friday afternoon at 4pm

- Participants will throw 10 darts each
- Scores are collected by the WAA all year, with the winners announced at the end of the year
- There is both a Primitive and Modern division
- There will be some gear available for use, but personal gear is recommended if you have it

This will be an official ISAC competition in conjunction with the World Atlatl Association.
